Rising Star (A) and (B) Group are only open to students of Hong Kong Chess and Go Academy (including in-center and outreach classes).

Registration Deadline: Thursday, April 9, 2025. Registration will close once all places are filled.

### **Tournament System:**

- \* All groups will use the Swiss pairing system. The Chinese counting method (area scoring) will be used to determine results (Black gives 3¼ points komi).
- \* Four to five rounds will be played, depending on the number of participants.
- \* Absence from any round will be considered a forfeit. The Chief Arbiter's decision is final and not subject to appeal.

Note: If a participant is found to have misrepresented their grade level to enter a group, the Academy reserves the right to disqualify the player and void their results. The entry fee will not be refunded.

Late Arrival: Participants should arrive at the venue at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start of each round. Timing will begin when the competition is officially announced by the organizer. Any participant who is 10 minutes late will forfeit the round. Being 10 minutes late will result in a forfeit.

### **Promotion Rewards:**

- \* Rising Star (A) Group: Champion will be promoted to 24 kyu; 1st Runner-up to 25 kyu; 2nd Runner-up to 25 kyu.
- \* Rising Star (B) Group: Champion will be promoted to 27 kyu; 1st Runner-up to 28 kyu; 2nd Runner-up to 28 kyu.

### **School Team Awards:**

Open Group Team Award: Calculated based on the results of participants from the same school (including primary schools and kindergartens) in the Secondary, Senior Primary, Middle Primary, Junior Primary, and Kindergarten Groups.

- \* Kindergarten Group Team Award: Calculated based on the results of participants from

the same school (including primary schools and kindergartens) in the Rising Star (A) and Rising Star (B) Groups.

\* The Open Group and Kindergarten Group Team Awards each have Champion, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up, and 3rd Runner-up trophies.

\* Team Score Calculation Method:

\* The total game points earned by all participants from the same school will be summed. Schools with fewer than 3 participants are not eligible for team awards.

\* Each participant earns 1 point for their school. Additional points are awarded for top individual placements within each group: Champion (10 pts), 1st Runner-up (7 pts), 2nd Runner-up (6 pts), 3rd Runner-up (5 pts), 5th place (4 pts), 6th place (3 pts), 7th place (2 pts), 8th place (1 pt).

\* The top 4 schools with the highest total points will receive awards. No ties will be allowed for award positions. In case of a tie in total points, the school with more Champions across all groups will rank higher. If still tied, the school with more 1st Runner-ups will rank higher, and so on.

1. Cheung Chau Theatre was completed in 1931 and is listed as a Grade III historic building. After revitalization, it has reopened its silver screen under the name of a traditional cultural base. It features an information centre, a boutique shop, and multiple themed zones for visitors to explore.

Peace Bun Workshop

Guests can personally make auspicious peace buns to take blessings home. Suitable for the whole family to participate together, experience kneading the dough, wrapping the buns, and finally stamping them with the peace seal. The activity also helps participants better understand the effort behind food preparation.

2. Pak Tai

The Cheung Chau Yuk Hui Temple (Pak Tai Temple) was built in the 48th year of the Qianlong Emperor's reign (1783), with a history of over 230 years. It is graded as a Grade I historic building by the Antiquities Advisory Board and is the starting point for the Cheung Chau Tai Ching Festival parade. You can see the colorful seven-hued dragon on the temple roof, as well as two antiquities inside the hall - a Qing Dynasty gilt wood carving and a Song Dynasty iron greatsword.
